



Red Cross CPR / First Aid Classes Fact Sheet

Southern Pharmacy is proud to offer CPR/First Aid training courses taught by Red Cross certified instructors to the staff of our customer facilities! We are now offering multiple educational options to better meet your needs:

Traditional In-Person Instruction

- Offered up to once per quarter per facility based on facility request and instructor availability
- Minimum class size is 5 participants with a minimum fee of \$200 per class. If fewer than five participants attend, you will still be charged the minimum fee of \$200 for that class session.
- Maximum class size is 10 participants. Please contact your assigned instructor to ask if accommodations can be made should a need arise to have more than 10 in a class.
- If a class is cancelled with less than 24-hour notice, the minimum fee of \$200 will be charged

Hybrid Learning Option

- Online class created and encouraged by the Red Cross
- Online portion completed by staff at their own pace access can be provided within 72 hours of notifying pharmacy and can be completed on computer, tablet, or smart phone
- Staff has 90 days to complete skills check-off. Check off scheduled and performed by SPS staff member
- Can be scheduled at any time by notifying pharmacy to grant access
- No minimum number of students per class

Course Rates Per Student (covers the cost of the card and fees from the Red Cross):

CPR/First Aid/AED	\$45/student	\$35/student

Billing Notes

- SPS staff will email the billing department a copy of the sign in sheet for the class or a listing of names who have completed the skills check-off along with the fee to be charged to the account. The charges will appear on your house stock account.
- Southern Pharmacy staff members are not allowed to collect payment from the facility or the staff on site, unless directed by instructor.
- The facility can collect cash from the staff and send directly to Southern Pharmacy Services as payment, with a memo that it is for CPR charges.

Important Info for In-Person Learning:

- Students must arrive on time for class and are not permitted to leave early or certification will not be awarded. There will be a 15-minute grace period for the start of classes.
- Southern Pharmacy Services does not keep copies of the CPR cards issued to students
- Only current staff of the facility may attend class



CPRHybrid Course

Our hybrid CPR course lets staff obtain a Red Cross CPR certification quicker by combining online and in-person training. The course combines self-paced online learning with a convenient, instructor-led check-off session at your facility. This way, staff can become CPR certified in the shortest amount of time.

Benefits to Students:

- self-paced online modules that allow students to stop and resume after any module
- online training that can be completed on a computer, smartphone, or tablet
- earning a 2-year certificate by completing skills check-off within 90 days

Benefits to Communities:

- less time off the floor for staff
- staff certified quicker
- no minimum number of students per in-person class
- no cost for incomplete certifications
- online access for staff provided with 72 hour notice to pharmacy
